After graduating from Loughborough University in the United Kingdom in 1981 with an Aeronautical Engineering degree, Mr. Wong started his career in aviation as an Assistant Airport Manager with the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore at Changi Airport. He returned to Hong Kong in 1986, broadening his aviation experience by leading a ground operations team for a Hong Kong based cargo airline.

He returned to the field of airport management when he joined the Hong Kong Civil Aviation Department in 1988. Over a period of 8 years, he was involved in all aspects of the intensive day-to-day management of Hong Kong's busy Kai Tak Airport, rising to the position of Deputy Airport General Manager.

Mr. Wong joined the management team of the Airport Authority of Hong Kong in 1996, as the General Manager (Operation Support) responsible for a wide range of safety, security and contingency planning issues at the new airport. He was appointed as the General Manager, Terminal Business, in 2001 responsible for the operation of the passenger terminal and all matters related to passenger facilitation and property leasing at Hong Kong International Airport.

In December 2006, Eric was appointed to be the Chief Executive Officer of the Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport in Zhejiang Province of China. He left Hangzhou Airport to join NetJets Business Aviation Limited in May 2011.
